You can help by donating any of the items listed below.

Most needed items:

- ◆ Used cell phones, smart phones, iPods and iPads (which will be sent to SmartphoneRecycling.com to raise funds for our program)
- ◆ CATA bus passes (student and adult)
- ◆ Gift cards for Kroger, Meijer, Target or Walmart
- ◆ Gas cards
- ◆ Paper towel, Kleenex, toilet paper
- ◆ Bleach, spray cleaner, Pine Sol, Scrubbing Bubbles, Soft Scrub, toilet cleaner, glass cleaner
- ◆ Mops, brooms, sponges, wipes, SOS pads, rubber gloves
- ◆ Laundry soap, hand soap, dish soap
- ◆ New pillows
- ◆ New or gently used pots and pans

Less urgent but often needed items:

- ◆ Socks and underwear (new) for women & children
- ◆ New or gently used backpacks

Holiday needs:

- ◆ Gift cards, such as Meijer, Kroger, Target, Walmart, etc. (can be used for food or other assistance for families)
- ◆ Gas cards
- ◆ Gifts for teens and adult women
